学校简介

河滨华夏中文学校的前母校，圣地亚哥华夏中文学校，是由一群热心海外中文教育的华人学者于一九九七年四月创办的非政治、非宗教、非盈利的教育机构。河滨分校成立于二零零五年十月，独立于二零一一年，面向河滨市及其周边地区所有对中文学习有兴趣者招生。以教授简体汉字、汉语拼音为主，附设多种中华文化艺术课，并为河滨学区提供第二外语学分班课程。

组织机构

Overview

Riverside Hua Xia Chinese School (RHXCS) was founded in 1997 as a non-profit, non-religious, and non-political educational organization.

RHXCS offers Pin-Yin and simplified Chinese classes for children at different levels, bilingual classes, and short-term adult classes. Students 7th grade and up at Riverside Unified School District can elect our credit classes as their high school elective courses. The classes are on Saturday afternoons from 1:00 - 4:00. The first two hours are language classes. The third hour is for Chinese culture enrichment, such as Chinese cuisine, Chinese arts and crafts, children poetry, music, games, chess, martial arts, and folk songs, etc.



Governance of the School

The mission and the operations of the school are overseen primarily by three groups. The Board of Directors meets on a regular basis to set the strategic direction, budget, and policies for the school. The Principal Executive Committee consisting of principal and vice principals is responsible for the operations of the school. The school PTA provides financial and volunteer support for the school's mission and educational activities.

School Funding

The school's operations and activities are funded primarily by students' tuition payments, as well as by donations from non-profit organizations, private companies and individuals.

School Faculty

The school has publicly recruited, selected, and hired a group of qualified bilingual teachers in Chinese and English. All our teachers, with bachelor degrees or higher, have strong commitment to Chinese teaching and can provide excellent learning experiences to our students.

- Pin-Yin and simplified Chinese classes for all children
- Bilingual classes for those whose primary language is English
- Credit classes (7th grade and up)
- Short-term Chinese classes for adults
